

RESOLUTION No. 15-006

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Marlin that a Justice Assistance Grant Program for safety equipment and vehicles be operated for fiscal year 2015-2016.

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division, Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Mayor as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN approves submission of the grant application for the Justice Assistance Grant for safety equipment and vehicles to the Criminal Justice Division, Office of the Governor.
