

Resolution No. 15-007

A Resolution of the City of Marlin authorizing the lease-purchase of five police units from American National Leasing; sourcing the vehicles from the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) BuyBoard with upfitting by Defender Supply.

Whereas, the City of Marlin maintains a full time police department; and

Whereas, emergency service requires a high degree of dependability from its rolling stock, and

Whereas, the Marlin Police Department's fleet is aging and in dire need of replacement, and

Whereas, a lease-purchase agreement has been offered by American National Leasing to pay for the purchase and upfitting of five police units; and

Whereas, the City is a member of the Texas Association of School Boards BuyBoard, a cooperative purchasing group, and thus eligible to acquire the vehicles at advantageous pricing, and

Whereas, Defender Supply, a professional vehicle upfitter, will furnish and install the specified police equipment to prepare the units for duty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN:

That the Mayor be authorized to sign, on behalf of the City of Marlin, the lease-purchase agreement with American National Leasing for the acquisition of five new police vehicles, including specified equipment and upfitting services.

That the capital line item of \$40,000 approved in the current budget for police vehicles be appropriated as the first year's payment on the lease-purchase.
